Curriculum News



The themes for this month are Halloween, Autumn and Day/Night.



We will be providing opportunities for the children to become aware of the seasons of Autumn and Halloween through multi-sensory play activities,



Suggested activities to do with your child at home

1. There are four main characters within the school (Winnie the Pooh, Piglet, Eeyore, and Tigger). Your child has now been allocated a group. If possible, you can talk to your child about these characters at home?
2. Placemats for dinner, with your child's character group, will be sent home to help reinforce their character groups and to practice using their knife and fork when eating. Please encourage them to set their own placemat on a daily basis and use their knife and fork when eating.
3. Play "I Spy", focus in on colours, for e.g. "I spy someone wearing a blue jumper, black shoes etc"
4. Engage with your child during play. This will help them to develop their concentration and play more purposefully with the equipment. You will also be introducing a wider range of vocabulary.



Songs and Rhymes.

The children will be revising songs and rhymes covered in September.

We will also introduce additional nursery rhymes and theme related songs. Please see songs and rhymes attached!

Children should be able to use the toilet on their own. This includes pulling up and down their pants/trousers/skirts/tights, wiping themselves, flushing toilet and washing/drying their hands. Please help them become independent at home.

Let your child practice putting on their own coat.
