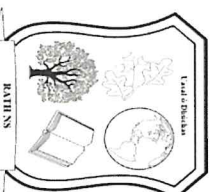


# *Scoil Náisiúnta an Chroí Ró-Naofa*

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## **Digital Learning Plan 2020-2023**

### **1. Introduction**

This document records the outcomes of our current digital learning plan, including targets and the actions we will implement to meet the targets.

#### **1.1 School Details:**

- Scoil Náisiúnta an Chroí Ró-Naofa is a Catholic, co-educational primary school located in Rath, Ballybrrtas, Co. Laois. At present we are an eight mainstream classroom school with two special classes for children with autism. We currently have 215 pupils and our staff includes the principal, 8 mainstream classroom teachers, 2 special class teachers, 4 special education teachers, 10 SNAs and a school secretary.

#### **1.2 School Vision:**

- Our Catholic school is a place where the children will feel safe, happy and respected. We aim to provide them with a rich, broad and varied learning experience so that all children enjoy success and come to realise their own and other's uniqueness and talents. We at Rath N.S. endeavour to integrate Digital Learning in a meaningful way in line with these values. We aim to explore the potential of Digital Learning to enhance learning across all subject areas. We seek to provide the children with opportunities to develop lifelong learning skills that will support their learning as they move through primary and into secondary education.

#### **1.3 Brief account of the use of digital technologies in the school to date:**

- We use technology in line with available ICT infrastructure.
- Every mainstream classroom is equipped with an Interactive Whiteboard and a teacher's laptop with internet access.
- A networked photocopier is located in the main office.
- We have four SEN rooms, all of which have interactive whiteboards and each SET teacher has their own laptop.

- A digital camera is available in the office.
- Four classrooms are equipped with a desktop computer.
- The school broadband is wired and was upgraded to fibre optic in 2019. We installed an integrated wireless system in Spring 2020.
- We currently use *Aladdin* to record student data, attendance and assessment results.
- In 2018 and 2019 parent-teacher meetings were organised through *Aladdin* and Summer Reports were also uploaded to *Aladdin*.
- Payments are received electronically via *Aladdin* e-Payments system and are made electronically using online banking.
- Communication with parents is largely online and paperless; emails, newsletters, use of *Aladdin* app.
- Third to Sixth class attend a computer class in the school once a week for 12 weeks which is run in partnership with a local business *Rionnaire Tech*.

## **2. The focus of this Digital Learning Plan**

We undertook a digital learning evaluation in our school during the period December 2019 to March 2020. We evaluated our progress using the following sources of evidence:

- Digital Learning Team formed: A focus group of teachers was established to work on developing our digital learning plan. The DL Team includes Tommy Fitzgerald (Principal), Niall Walsh (Class Teacher) and Selina O'Brien (Class Teacher). Regular meetings were scheduled to evaluate our current digital practices and gather information from staff to help develop our Digital Learning Plan.
- Observations/feedback from members of staff (online survey).
- Audit of ICT equipment available in the school.
- A focus group session with our Student Council was carried out to elicit the views of older pupils on the use of digital technologies in the school and classroom to reflect on their digital learning experiences.

### 2.3. These are a summary of our strengths with regards to digital learning

- A number of staff members have completed summer courses and other CPD courses in order to enhance the use of digital technologies to assist teaching, learning and assessment.
- 69% of staff are very comfortable at using Digital Technologies to enhance the Learner Experience in their classes. Following two years of work with Ríomhaire Tech, the pupils in the senior classes are quite proficient in using digital technologies to source information and use Microsoft Word and Powerpoint.
- The Board of Management and the Parents' Association are very supportive in providing funding for the provision of the best digital technologies available to schools.
- The staff as a whole are interested in engaging in whole school CPD to enhance the use of digital technologies in our school. 100% of teachers state that they are willing to do more digital technology related CPD.
- 100% of students surveyed indicated that they would like to use digital technologies more in the classroom. They want to work on creating presentations, play educational games and conduct research for projects.

### 2.4 This is what we are going to focus on to improve our digital learning practice further

- Formation of a Digital Learning Team.
- Investment in Digital technologies for use by pupils and staff.
- Staff will engage in CPD facilitated by members of the Digital Learning Team and outside agencies.
- Identification of hardware and software required for pupils to actively engage in using digital technologies to create content.
- Creation of greater opportunities for collaboration through the use of digital technologies.
