LEARNING TOPICS

Please read below the class topics children are learning about in Term 1a, 2024 - 2025.

Naíscoil

We're having a gradual settling in period at Naíscoil Neachtain. During September, the children are learning all about their Naíscoil. They're painting, singing and playing in a variety of ways as well as getting to know each other and the staff. Follow us on *Seesaw!*

Rang 1

Rang 1 children are learning about the topic *Myself*. They are also learning about their families and about other people who help them. The children are reading *The Gingerbread Man*, a story which helps them learn about safety. The children are learning the different body parts through stories, rhymes, action songs and various practical activities.

Rang 2

Wonderful Me! is the topic for children in Rang 2 this half-term. They will explore who they are, recognising what they can do, identifying their favourite things and recognising what makes them special. The children will be encouraged to develop a positive attitude to learning. They will also be learning all about the Senses.

Rang 3

Rang 3 children are learning about *My Locality* in term 1a. They are learning about the local area – facilities, services, historic buildings and community buildings, schools, etc. They are also learning about the physical aspects of the local environment. The children will also be learning about Autumn.

Rang 4

Rang 4 children will be learning about the weather in Term 1a. They will have the opportunity to learn about the seasons and the types of weather we have here in Ireland and around the world. The children will also be learning about Autumn and will go on a nature walk.

Ranganna 5 / 6 / 7

Children in Ranganna 5, 6 and 7 are learning about kindness and charities in Term 1a. They will be researching the many great local and international charities that play a vital role in our communities. They will explore the importance and value of showing kindness to themselves and others and of supporting various charities regularly.
