Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware, our teachers will be scheduling a face-to-face interview/phone call for the parent/teacher interviews in the coming weeks to inform you of progress and concerns relating to academic and pastoral matters (attendance, punctuality, homework, behaviour etc.).

Please ensure that you attend the meeting or can take the phone call at the organised day/time.

Please be aware that if you have any issues/concerns at any time about your son, contact the teacher on the class app or phone the school (02890-351032) to arrange a meeting and we will address the issue/concern. We ask that you **DO NOT** approach the teacher during the school day, especially in the morning when the boys are coming into school or when they are leaving at home time, as the teacher cannot be distracted for health and safety reasons.

REMINDER: HCB School Uniform consists of:

- Black jumper (with school crest)
- Red Polo shirt
- Plain Black trousers
- Plain black shoes/black trainers (no stripes/designs)
- Black shorts can be worn in the summer months.
- Parents/guardians are asked to label all items of clothing clearly with their child's name.
- On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school (watches are not considered items of jewellery and may be worn). Earrings **ARE NOT PERMITTED**.
- Hair: Lines or dyes **ARE NOT PERMITTED**.



All pupils should wear their full P.E Uniform on their P.E days.

- Black Jogger Bottoms, White Polo Shirt/ Normal Black School Jumper with HCB Crest & Plain Black Trainers (no stripes/designs).
