Parent Information and Key Dates for School return

- School Dinners: The current price of a school meal is £2.65. Your son may be entitled to Free School Meals. To check this, you can contact the Education Authority Belfast on 02890564000 and ask to speak to someone in the department of free school meals and uniform grants. Alternatively, apply online via <u>https://www.eani.org.uk/financialhelp/free-school-meals-uniform-grants</u>
- Packed Lunches: Sandwiches or a bread based item, Fruit / vegetables/ yoghurt, Water / milk / non fizzy juice and one treat.
- Water: All children are encouraged to carry a plastic bottle of water in their schoolbags to drink throughout the day. No flavoured water!
- Healthy eating at Holy Cross should not be seen in isolation. The Healthy Eating Policy of Holy Cross Boys' is an integral part of our PDMU policy. It involves a partnership between teachers and parents. We will have a Healthy Eating Ambassador each week to help promote healthy eating.
- Break: Children can now have a small bread-based snack and a yoghurt alongside fruit and/or vegetables. The only drinks taken should be either milk or water. Bread based snacks with a sugar free filling e.g. plain bread sticks, bread



rolls, sandwiches of ham, tuna, cheese etc. Scones, muffins or pancakes can be used occasionally as they contain some sugar and may cause tooth decay if taken frequently.

Healthy Lunch Choices: In PDMU (Personal Development, Mutual Understanding) lessons we are trying to develop the idea of a balanced diet and healthy lifestyle which will be carried on into adult life. For this reason, we encourage pupils to include a piece of fruit, sandwiches, and a non-fizzy or sugar free drink in their lunch as well as a treat (biscuit).

Pupil Information and Consent Form: These forms will be sent home on Wednesday 28th August 2024. Please ensure that you complete and sign the Pupil Information and Consent Form (Copy Attached below) and return it to the class teacher ASAP. It is essential that we have this information. Please contact the school if you have any medical issues/concerns regarding your son that the school should know about.

HCB School Uniform

Pupils will wear their full school uniform on the first day back on Wednesday 28th August 2024.



Attendance

- Holy Cross Boys' PS is committed to a positive policy of encouraging pupils to attend school regularly. The school will work with parents, pupils and outside agencies to secure this aim.
- Rewarding Pupils with Excellent and Improved Attendance: Pupils who attend School for 5 days of the week will automatically receive a Written Homework Pass for the following Thursday night. Our Student Council brought in this initiative, and it has helped to encourage improved attendance for many pupils. We also celebrate all our pupils who put in a great effort with attendance at every opportunity throughout the school year and reward these pupils at the mid and end of each term with prizes and organise Friday visits to Solitude.
- Friday is typically the worst attended day and so we introduced the Friday Tuckshop last year (which takes place every Friday, starting Friday 6th September 2024) to encourage the boys to come in on that day. A new initiative from our Student Council, entitled Football Top Friday (FREE) which will replace Trainer Tuesday, is another incentive to improve Friday attendance and will start on Friday 6th September. It IS NOT a non-uniform day. Pupils will wear their football top over their red polo shirt.
- Poor Attendance: Pupils who have a history of poor attendance will continue to be monitored on a regular basis. Pupils who have had poor attendance for the last school year 2023-2024 will be placed on a school monitoring list, which will be checked weekly with class visits from Mr McArevey and Mr Curran. Pupils are encouraged not to take holidays during term time. If a pupil goes on a holiday during term time, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
