

Dear Tempo Primary School

Fermanagh and Omagh District Council in partnership with Fermanagh Rural Community Initiative continue to deliver REAP (Rural Economic Accelerator Programme). The programme is funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund and delivered in conjunction with South West College.

REAP currently offer the Classroom Support package which incorporates work experience opportunities alongside a range of training such as Paediatric First Aid, Food Hygiene, Sounds Write Linguistic Phonics, Child Protection, Autism Awareness etc.

All the training and support provided is free to the participant.

To be eligible for the REAP Programme the participant must be economically inactive, that is, those who are not in full-time/part time employment or are required to attend a Jobs and Benefits Office Job Coach to look for work.

REAP provides an opportunity for those who are preparing to move into employment or to progress with further or higher education to receive support appropriate to their needs.
