World Book Day 2026



To celebrate World Book Day 2025 a variety of activities have been planned.

Our book Fair will arrive in school on Friday 20th February. Children will receive a voucher for books (please keep this safe as we have no spares). Your child/ren will have the opportunity to purchase books each day (week beginning 23rd February). The book Fair will leave on the morning of Friday 27th Feb.

Parents can accompany children to buy books each morning (9am - 9.30am) should you wish. All classes will have the opportunity to visit the book fair each day.

On World Book Day (5th March) children in P1 - P3 can dress up as their favourite book character and bring their book to school with them on this day.

Children P4 - P7 can dress up or wear their pyjamas as in recent years.

On this day children will be completing fun, book related activities in school.

A homework competition will be set for the event and judged on World Book Day.

School Meals

A copy of the new school meals menu has been attached to this newsletter. This will begin on 16th February when we return after half-term. Please note the price increase to £3.10 per day (15.50 per week) from 5th January 2026.

Our school kitchen continues to offer nutritious school dinners throughout the school year, and we encourage you to consider using our school meals service to provide food at lunchtime for your child. All children must be marked each day for school meals and packed lunches on the school app.

Parents will be charged in after schools for the next hours' session if very late for collection of children due to staffing costs.
