*Please be aware that under Department of Education guidelines, children **must** bring a **healthy break** to school each day. No chocolate, sweets or crisps will be allowed.*

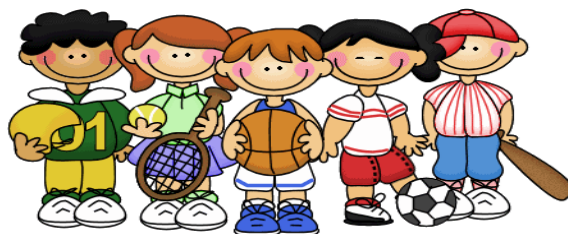
*Water is always available for children to refill their bottles each day.*
