### Eco Schools Green Flag

We are delighted to confirm that we have been successful in being awarded our Eco-Schools Green Flag in June 2024. We will hold the flag for two years and will be reapplying in March 2026.

The assessors made the following comments about the **strengths** of our school evident in the application:

We are so impressed with all the great work that Miss Cunning and the Eco-Committee have prompted and organised at St. MacNissi's Primary School. The environmental review and the action plan are both very detailed and include thoughtful evaluation. St. MacNissi's Eco-Schools programme is exemplary in its empowerment of students. It was apparent in the application but also in person when visiting the school that students are encouraged to take on leadership roles and complete tasks as part of the Eco-Committee. It is also clear that the whole school has opportunities to learn and take part in important environmental activities at the school. The school has been ambitious and taken on a variety of projects, and they have also done a great job of collecting various data points about topic knowledge, litter, waste audits, etc.

The assessors made the following **suggestions** which may enhance our Eco-Schools programme going forward:

Continue the great work you have started on biodiversity and on the data collection, especially about waste. Use the excellent ideas for further improvement you noted in your action plan. Also, keep an eye out for upcoming grants on our Keep Northern Ireland Beautiful website.


### Child Protection and Safeguarding

### **Nut Allergies**

We have several children in school who suffer from nut and other allergies. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food group in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Consequently, we must ask that you do not send nuts or nut products into school (either for healthy break or packed lunch). This includes peanut paste, Nutella, all nuts and cooking oil containing peanut oil, as well as foods containing nuts such as cereals and muesli bars. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

Some people, especially those allergic to peanuts, may have allergic reactions after eating lupin or foods containing ingredients from lupin.

Our school catering team have requested that parents advise if their child has an allergy related to this.


