- **Síntiús ar son Carthanachtaí / Charitable donations**

Mar is eol daoibh bhí pacáiste de ghníomhaíochtaí éagsúla scoile curtha le chéile roimh an Nollaig chun airgead a bhailiú ar son carthanachtaí áitiúla. Ní raibh an costas €3 don phictúrlann ar son Naomh Uinsean de Pól i Mainistir na Corann curtha san áireamh ag an am. Chomh maith le sin tháinig Orla Farmer, iar imreoir camógaíochta le Corcaigh ag lorg cúnaimh ón scoil chun tacú le 10,000 crann a chur i gCéinia san Afraic. Tacaíonn feachtas Orla leis an bhfeachtas atá idir lámh againn ó thaobh Scoileanna Glasa de. Tá an scoil ag oibriú ar an 6ú Bhrat Glas do Saoránaigh Domhanda - Bruscar agus dramhaíl. Tiocfaidh Orla isteach chun labhairt le R1-R6 faoin obair seo san Afraic agus faoi chúrsaí sláinte, aclaí agus folláine.

As you are aware, the school organised a package of activities before Christmas that included events to raise money for charity. The €3 to attend the cinema just before Christmas in aid of Midleton St. Vincent de Paul was not included in the original package. In addition, Orla Farmer, former Cork camogie player, invited all schools in the locality to assist her in her endeavours to plant 10,000 trees in Kenya, Africa. We were very happy to take part. Orla's campaign is in keeping with our Green School's campaign. We are working towards the 6th Green Flag under the heading Global Citizenship - Litter and Waste. Orla will speak to 1st - 6th classes about her work in Africa and health, fitness and wellness matters.

- **Pacáiste Gníomhaíochtaí Scoile nua 2024 / New School Activities Packages 2024**

Tá pacáiste de ghníomhaíochtaí éagsúla scoile ar son Naíonáin Bheaga go Rang a Sé curtha le chéile ag an scoil don athbhliain. The school is organising further packages of activities for the children from Junior Infants to 6th class.
