Settling In

During September our priority is ensuring the smooth transition of all the children from home to school. Please remember...

We would kindly ask parents for a voluntary contribution of £4 per week for school funds, this is used to provide a daily nutritious snack for your child and for schools trips and events throughout the year, this should be paid in a named purse/envelope.

School dinners

If you are entitled to free school meals please ensure that you have applied for them otherwise you will have to pay until the school has received confirmation. School dinners cost £12.50 per week, this is to be paid on a Monday morning, **week beginning 23rd September.**

Please label all clothes, jumpers, coats, hats etc with your child's name.



Additional Needs

Each school must have in place a record of children who are experiencing any difficulties which may affect their education. Such difficulties, large or small, may include: a physical difficulty, sight, hearing or speech difficulty, or emotional and behavioural problems. If you/we do not think your child is performing to the best of their ability Mrs Durnin/ Mrs Conway will have a chat with you and decide how best to improve the situation. However it is our policy (with parental permission) to refer children as early as possible to ensure your child gets the best start possible.

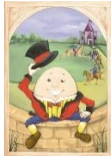


Colour
