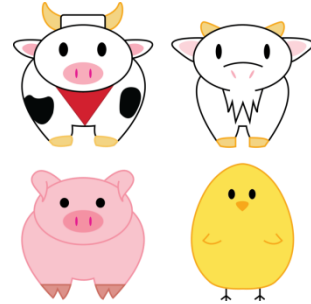
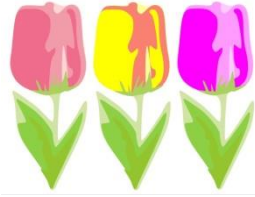

Look for oval in the house and in the environment.

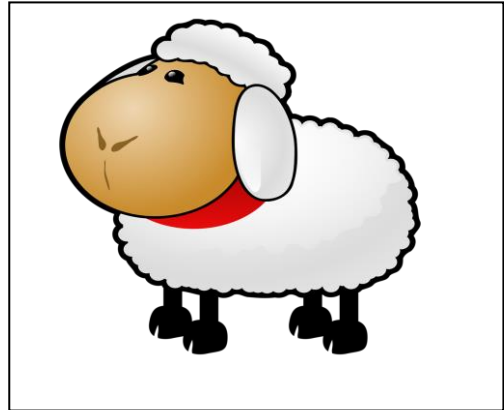
Encourage your child to rote and touch count to 10. Help them to recognize numbers 1-10.
