## **June Learning Focus**



Theme: We're All Going on a Summer Holiday.

Colour: Revision of all colours

Shape: Consolidation of all shapes

As we embark on our final month of the school year, our theme is 'We're All Going on a Summer Holiday.' This exciting theme will not only prepare our children for the upcoming break but also spark their imaginations of the world around them. Here are some engaging ideas for you to explore with your child at home.

### **Exploring Different Destinations**

- Books and Stories: Read picture books about different holiday destinations. Discuss places like the beach, mountains, countryside and cities.
- Map Activities: Look at maps and globes together. Show your child where different countries are and talk about how people travel to those places.

### Creative Arts and Crafts

- Postcard Creations: Have you child design and make postcards. They can mark-make and have a go at writing their name on them.
- Souvenir Making: Create 'souvenirs' from imaginary trips using craft materials. Think seashell necklaces and paper airplane tickets.

#### **Sensory Play**

- Beach in a Box: Fill a shallow box with sand and small toys. Let your child build sandcastles, dig and explore.
- Water Play: Set up a water play area with toy boats, cups and scoops to mimic seaside fun.

Music and Movement

- Travel Songs: Sing songs about travel and holidays, such as 'The Wheels on the Bus' or 'Row, Row, Row Your Boat'.
- Dance Around the World: Introduce music from different cultures and encourage your child to dance and move to the rhythms.

Practical Life Skills

- Packing a Bag: Practice packing a small bag for an imaginary trip. Discuss what items are needed and why.
- Picnic Planning: Organise a picnic and let your child help with planning, preparing snacks and setting up.

We hope you enjoy these moments of learning and fun together!

In Nursery, during the month of June we will be consolidating our awareness of many concepts and skills taught this year, including:

- Practising songs, rhymes and poems.
- Using mathematical language and learning about problem solving, prepositional language, pattern, number and shapes through play.
- Providing a print rich environment through access to books, mark making opportunities and phonetical games.
- Encouraging children to be independent, take on roles & responsibilities, participate in conflict resolution, be considerate to others and concentrate on a directed tasks.

We will also spend time preparing our children for the transition to Year 1. Children who are moving into our primary school will take part in a transition programme where they will get the opportunity to see their new teacher and classroom.

## **Nursery Fund**





If you are unsure how to pay for Nursery Fund please don't hesitate to approach the Nursery staff or Mrs Brown for assistance.




## St James's PS & NU Value of the Month

You may want to talk with your child about what determination is.


Determination in Nursery can be ... not giving up when things are hard.
