May Numeracy	Mental Arithmetic	Continue with M.A. tests (at least one a week) Continue with the next 1-a-week maths homework
	Number work	Ratio – Find the ratio between various items and numbers eg 30 children in a class. 1/3 are boys what is the ratio of boys:girls answer: 1:2 Factors – write all the factors on a given number eg: the factors of 36 are 1,2,3,4,9,12,18,36
	Fractions	Fractions – Counting items and sorting into fractions
	Measure	Find everyday objects in your kitchen to weigh. Look at the volume of liquid containers.
	Mathletics	Mathletics – Continue to work on any red or orange topics as these are the areas that need attention (15 daily)
Literacy	Spellings	Complete any remaining units - Complete Spelling activity home workbook for these two units
	Reading	Continue to read for pleasure – Accelerated reading books or any books you have at home. You will be able to take an A.R. test from your home. See online resources for links to e-books and other suitable reading resources
	Handwriting	Focus upper and lower and case formation using proper joins. Choose a section from your reading book to write by hand.
	Grammar	Use online activities free of charge from Twinkl and Primary resources.co.uk to find out about adding speech marks to a text.
