Regarding child protection and safeguarding, I would ask that even prior to school starting in the mornings, please report to the school office when arriving at school and do not proceed through the building into classrooms. I would be grateful if you would also share this information with relatives.

Uniform:

As we enter the summer term, I would remind parents that girls may wear school summer dresses if they wish. If in the event of hotter weather pupils wish to wear shorts, these should be in line with the school's uniform policy.

Booking of School Meals:



Parents are now aware of the new choice menu operating in school and which pupils are enjoying. I would ask once again to please make sure your child's meal is ordered **before 9:00 am** each day.

I would also stress that it is very important that pupils are made aware of the meal you have chosen for them when they come to school.

Pupils will only receive the meal which has been ordered by their parent.



Week Commencing Monday 20 April 2026:

Monday: Movement Monday activities for **P5F/P5H/P6/P7** pupils during school from 1:00 – 2:00 pm. Pupils from these classes should wear top half school uniform and bottom half sportswear & trainers.



P6/P7 girls – Football – shin guards are required where possible

P6/P7 boys – Table Tennis – no equipment is required

P5 girls – Tag Rugby – no equipment is required

P5 boys – Hockey – shin guards, gum shields and a hockey stick (if pupils have one) are required. School will provide hockey sticks if pupils do not have one)



Pupils should be collected/walk home/bus from the school at 3:00 pm as normal.

Chess Club will take place on Wednesday afternoons for P4 – P7 pupils beginning on 22 April 2026 from 3:00 – 4:00 pm. The club will continue on the following dates:

29 April, 06, 13, 20 May & 10 June 2026. The cost is **£5 per pupil** for the 6-week block, places are limited to 20. If your child would like to attend, please book and pay via Parentpay **no later than Tuesday 21 April.**

Cookery Club will run on Thursday afternoons beginning on 23 April 2026 for P5 – P7 pupils from 3:00 – 3:45 pm. The club will run in two 4-week blocks. The dates are as follows:

Block 1: Thursday 23, 30 April, 07, 14 May 2026

The cost is **£12 per pupil**. Places are restricted to **12** per block. You may book and pay for **either** Block 1 **OR** Block 2 **but not both**. If your child would like to attend, please choose **either** Block 1 **OR** Block 2 and pay this on Parentpay **no later than Tuesday 21 April.**

We hope to run a multisports club for P1 – P3 pupils on Tuesday afternoons. This **will not take place on Tuesday 21 April**, but further details will be sent out when dates become available.
