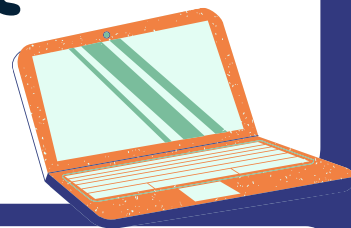




Parents Council Newsletter



Who we are

As most of you will know, Saints and Scholars has an active Parents Council which works to support and raise funds for the school, and for the benefit of all the pupils (which currently stand at just over 320 children).

The Council is composed of a committee of four (chair, vice-chair, secretary and treasurer) alongside two class representatives from each class, as well as a representative from the school itself.
