
# Swimming





7TH - 13TH


7th Feb 2026

association.


27th Feb 2026

Wacky Wednesday and Toy Thursday!



On February 10<sup>th</sup> we were lucky to have a lovely woman named Lucy from The Heritage Council help us make brownbread that we got to eat!!!






# LEGO LEAGUE!!!

3rd-6th class have been learning all about archaeology through the Lego Explore programme. They've conducted a dig in school and used Lego to build artefacts.






# PANCAKE TUESDAY


