Junior Infants - 2nd Class

Stationary to buy: *The items in the list below are essential items that should be brought into school during Week 1 in September.*

All other class books required are purchased by the school under the new Department of Education scheme.

The following do not need to be labelled:

- Pencils (10 triangular pencils)
- 4 erasers
- 3 large pritt-sticks glue
- 5 whiteboard markers (black)

Please label all of the *following* items individually

- A4+ Mesh folder for homework
- 1 x plastic button folders or strong folder
- Set of triangular colouring pencils - No twistables (1st and 2nd class only - school will provide crayons for Junior and Senior Infants)
- 2 pencil sharpeners that fit triangular pencils
- One pair of scissors (junior size as appropriate)
- One A4 double sided white board (*can be purchased in Mr. Price/Easons - please note that we have noticed that the whiteboards with frames around them tend to come apart leaving sharp edges and so are best avoided!*)
- Pencil case big enough to hold pencils / colours etc

- Overhead Headphones (with cord that plugs into ipad - no bluetooth connection)
- Wellingtons to be kept in school throughout the year-labelled
- Gardening Gloves-labelled
- An old oversized (adult) t-shirt to pull over uniform for art / messy activities - labelled

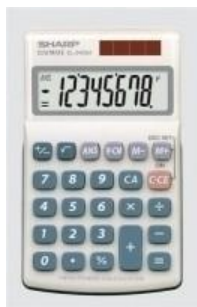
Senior Room Stationary List for 2025-2026

Please Label all items separately

These are essential items that should be brought into school week 1 in September. Please label each item separately. All other class books required are purchased by the school under the new Department of Education scheme.

- A4+ Mesh folder for homework
- 3 large pritt-sticks labelled- These should be brought into school first week
- 1 scissors (medium size)
- 1 mathematical set
- Small sellotape with dispenser
- 5 white board markers & small whiteboard
- 1 set of colours (colouring pencils), each item labelled
- 4 red pens, 4 blue pens, 2 highlighters -all labelled
- pencils for maths/rubbers/ sharpeners
- One small A4 double sided unlined white board (can be purchased in Mr. Price/Easons)
- Old over-sized t-shirt for painting etc.
- 1 School calculator (See image) - Sharp EL240SAB Basic Hand Held), or similar
- **One D Tin-Whistle**- can be purchased in The Record Room or Easons.
