The school website is kept up to date by Mrs L. Jamison and Miss Rennie reflecting all the good practice happening within the school and a comprehensive monthly newsletter is created and distributed to parents. The school has its own app to keep parents updated and informed about different activities happening within school. Teachers add a weekly contribution to the app focusing on activities covered by their class during that week.

Our school and its pupils participated in a great many community events and activities. These events provided additional skills and enjoyment as well as adding new experiences for children.

Sacramental Preparation

Within school Mrs Thom leads Sacramental Preparation. We prepare our pupils for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Year 3, First Holy Communion in Year 4 and the Sacrament of Confirmation in Year 7. This preparation involved taking the children on a weekly basis to complete the Alive-O programme and to learn prayers and hymns for the service. The children from Ballymoney Model CIPS made their Sacraments in St Patrick's and Our Lady's Church in Ballymoney along with the children of St Brigid's Primary School. We thank Father O'Brien, the Principal of St Brigid's Primary School, Mr O'Neill and the staff at St Brigid's for their support.

Academic Performance

End of Key Stage Assessments Below is a summary of our school academic performance.

End of Key Stage Data (Year 4 and Year 7)

Each year, the previous performance of the children who enter Year 4 and Year 7 is examined and appropriate targets which will promote improvement for these children are set in October. Assessments are normally carried out throughout the year, with a final 'Level' being reported in the end of year report.

Government targets recommend that the majority of children in Year 4 will reach Level 2 and that the majority of children in Year 7 will reach Level 4. It is the exception that children will reach Level 3 in Year 4 and Level 5 in Year 7.

Standardised Assessment

We continue to use the GL Digital Assessment Package as the school's main form of Y3-7 standardised assessment.

Security of the Pupils and Staff of the School and the School Premises

The security of pupils and staff is of paramount importance.

- During Term 1 a lock was fitted to the Year 7 mobile classroom door for added security.
- All exterior doors are secured using magnetic locks during school hours.
- Access to visitors is granted by the School Office, who release the door remotely. All visitors must sign in and are given a visitor's badge. They are also given a leaflet explaining some key child protection policies and procedures.
- CCTV cameras are installed around the school for added security.
- The school has an emergency action plan for evacuation and regular evacuations drill are carried out.
- The fire alarm system is checked weekly and fire extinguishers are serviced regularly.
- Risk assessments are an integral part of our routine.
- All contractors are signed in and briefed by the School Office/Building Supervisor.
- PAT testing was carried out as per EA guidelines.

Admissions Policy and Enrolment

Sixty-two applications had been received for Year 1 (mainstream) at the school in September 2018. Sixty applications were accepted.

The enrolment at the end of June 2019 was three hundred and ninety-eight pupils and of these, forty-nine transferred to secondary education.

Attendance is monitored monthly and parents informed on the school app. Pupil attendance from 1st September 2018 – 30th June 2019 was 96.2%.

Pastoral Care and Child Protection

The Safeguarding Team is made up of the Principal, Mrs Jamison, Designated Teacher (DT) for Child Protection is Mrs Carson and Deputy Designated Teacher (DDT) for Child Protection is Miss Mulholland. During Miss Mulholland's maternity leave, the Deputy Designated Teacher (DDT) role was covered by Mr McCullough. Responsibilities for Child Protection on the Board of Governors rest with Mr Clarke.

Concerns, referrals and contacts with outside agencies are maintained and documented as appropriate. Class teachers received updates throughout the year on a need to know basis. School staff received annual training led by Mrs Carson.

Mr McCullough as DDT attended 'Safeguarding Responsibilities for Deputy Designated Teachers' in October 2018.

All the Board of Governors attended EA Child Protection and Safeguarding training in February 2018.

Child Protection and Safeguarding is a stated item on the agenda at every meeting of the Board of Governors. This is a requirement of the Child Protection Act.

We received notice of a sustaining improvement inspection at the end of May 2018. The Principal and teachers were unable to comply with ETI due to the on-going industrial action by teaching unions. The Principal and Mrs Carson as Deputy Designated Teacher met with the District Inspector in September 2018 to complete the school's safeguarding inspection.

Special Educational Needs (SEN)

We identify the education and welfare needs of each child at the earliest opportunity to ensure early intervention and endeavour to cater for them accordingly. The identified educational needs of each child will be catered for by his/her class teacher through differentiation i.e. group and individual teaching, in-class support and if appropriate, through withdrawal for further specialised learning opportunities/intervention and/or additional support from existing staff and/or the appropriate agencies.

The Board of Governors oversee the school's policy and procedures on SEN. This area of responsibility is headed by Mrs Mack.

The school's SEN and Inclusion policy was reviewed and approved by the Board of Governors in Autumn 2017 and is compliant with the 1996 SEN Order and the SEN Code of Practice.

Year 7 Annual Reviews were completed in the first term for those children that would be transferring to secondary school in September 2019. Other Annual Reviews for those children within the school who also have a SEN Statement were completed in May and June 2019.

Special Needs vary as children move through school and the 'Stage' children are placed at will also vary. Children at Stage 2-5 have Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) which are updated at least twice each year and discussed with parents and support staff as necessary.

The school's accommodation remains accessible to all pupils.

Speech and Language Centre

Mrs Mack was the teacher of the Year 1 - 3 classroom assisted by classroom assistant Mrs Waide.

This classroom is primarily for children with speech and language difficulties, with the emphasis on developing their speech and language skills. However, here at Ballymoney Model, we also place emphasis on the social and emotional well-being of the child and therefore place great importance on integration. The children in our speech and language integrate with mainstream classes for subject such as play based learning, PE, assemblies and sacramental preparation. The children also join together for Christmas concerts and school trips. Integration is an important dimension within our school and the staff work hard to make this successful.

PE

PE continues to be delivered throughout the school by using the two school halls and the school's extensive grounds.

Football

Thank you to Miss Witherow who coached the senior football teams and Miss Hemphill who coached the junior football team. Once again we took part in a number of local tournaments.

Other Sports

Year 5 - 7 pupils attended a series of swimming lessons at the Joey Dunlop Leisure Centre. Children's achievements were celebrated in whole school assemblies and shared on the school website.
