Holycross National School received a grant in 2021 to implement initiatives aimed at addressing the digital divide and support our learners at risk of educational disadvantage as a consequence, as part of the Irish National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) a project under the Recovery and Resilience Facility funded by the European Union through NextGenerationEU.

This funding was used to purchase iPads to enable all children in the classroom to access digital technology. A whole class set of iPads is our aim, whereby, a timetable is drawn up to ensure all classrooms have equal and fair access to these devices, taking into consideration their age and stage in the curriculum.

The school staff upskilled in the use of Aladdin, in order to ensure effective communication between home and school, in order to ensure that no child is at a loss due to a gap in communication and knowledge of happenings within the school and the local community.
