



Holycross National School EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES POLICY

The teaching staff of Holycross National School in charge of school teams and choirs representing the school in inter school competitions and choral events have full responsibility for the management of the team/group. Lunchtime leagues and training sessions allow for participation by every child who wishes to be involved.

Adults transporting children to and from events in their car should

- Ensure that there is adequate insurance cover (Pupils are covered by Allianz 24hr Personal Accident Insurance – see attached.).
- Ensure that vehicle insurance, National Car Test (NCT) certification and road tax are all current and valid.
- Not carry more than the permitted number of passengers
- If a parent is transporting children to or from any extra-curricular activity, consent is required from the parents of the children involved and these consent forms are held by the school.
- Ensure the use of safety belts and child car seats/booster seats (in accordance with RSA legislation
- Obey the rules of the road
- **It is not permitted to be alone with one child at any time**
- Drop off at central locations and clearly state times of pick up and drop off.
- Parents are expected to be on time when collecting children from after school training sessions and from pick-up points after away matches.
- Children are expected to attend regularly, and parents / guardians should be on time to pick up their children after all activities.
