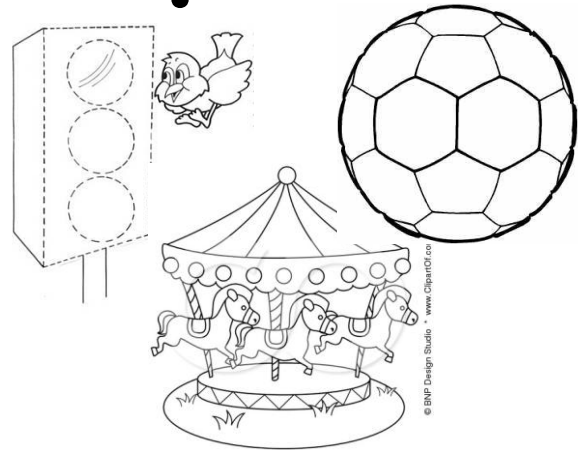

Settling In

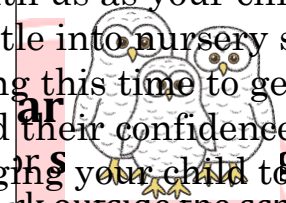

Additional Needs

Each school must have in place a record of children who are experiencing any difficulties which may effect their education. Such difficulties, large or small, may include: a physical difficulty, sight, hearing or speech difficulty, or emotional and behavioural problems. If you/we do not think your child is performing to the best of their ability Mrs Burke/Mrs O'Loughlin will have a chat with you and decide how best to improve the situation. However it is our policy (with parental permission) to refer children as early as possible to ensure your child gets the best start possible.

Please remember...

School funds can be paid in 3 instalments at £60 each or one payment at £180, whichever is more convenient. We accept cash, paypal or bank transfer. If you need further details please just ask.

Parental Responsibility

Please make sure you have fully completed the parental responsibility form. Legally we are required to ensure all those with parental responsibility are kept informed of their child's progress, if they so wish, but we depend on you to supply the information.

If information changes throughout the year please let us know, remember we may need to contact you if your child takes sick at school and also to keep you up to date with school events etc.

Parent Tip

Giving up the dummy will help :

Dummies at this age is a habit and no longer needed as a comforter. The longer you leave it the harder it will be.

Sickness – If your child is feeling unwell, please inform the school and keep them at home. Children with vomiting and/or diarrhea are asked to be 48hrs clear of both symptoms before returning to school.
