Extended Schools Programme 2025-2026



After School Club

Open to all pupils and offering homework supervision from P3 upwards. All children completing homework would need to bring their homework folder to the club. Running Thursday 2nd October; Thursday 9th October; Thursday 16th October; Thursday 23rd October.

Club runs from 3pm-4.30pm.

This club is fully funded by Extended Schools. Children can attend all or some weeks.

Core Kids Afterschool Club

Open to all pupils and offering sports (1st hour) and indoor recreational club (2nd hour). This club will run Thursday 6th November; Thursday 13th November; Thursday 20th November; Thursday 27th November; Thursday 4th December; Thursday 11th December.

Club runs from 3pm-5pm.

This club is **partially funded** by Extended Schools. The Extended Schools club is contributing just over half of the cost. This can only be booked as a 6-week block and the cost to families will be £30 altogether per child. We do need 15 pupils or more for this club to be viable. If the support isn't there it will unfortunately be cancelled. Core Kids provide an online booking system and more information will follow closer to the time.

After School Club

Open to all pupils and offering homework supervision from P3 upwards. All children completing homework would need to bring their homework folder to the club. Running Thursday 8th January; Thursday 15th January; Thursday 22nd January; Thursday 29th January; Thursday 5th February.

Club runs from 3pm-4.30pm.

This club is fully funded by Extended Schools. Children can attend all or some weeks.

Hockey Club

Open to P4-P7 pupils only due to safety. Mrs Pattison takes this club. It will run Thursday 19th February; Thursday 26th February; Thursday 5th March; Thursday 12th March; Thursday 19th March; Thursday 26th March.

Club runs 3pm-4.30pm

This club is fully funded by Extended Schools. It is best if the children attend the whole block. Any issues please contact Mrs Pattison. The children must have mouth guards and shin pads.

Paired Reading Club

This club will be for pupils in P1-P3. This is a club to promote parental involvement in teaching children to read. The child will attend with one parent or carer (grandparent/childminder). Extended Schools are funding our Accelerated Reader Programme, and this club supports this. It also brings in our parental involvement which Extended Schools promote.

It will run Thursday 19th February; Thursday 26th February; Thursday 5th March; Thursday 12th March; Thursday 19th March; Thursday 26th March.

Club runs 3pm-4.30pm

This club is fully funded by Extended Schools.

Parent/Carer and child can attend every week or some weeks.

Breakfast Club

Extended schools are **partially funding** a breakfast club running most mornings of the Spring Term commencing Monday 12th January 2026. Last day will be Friday 27th March, 2026. Extended Schools are funding the staffing of this club. Mrs Ovens and Mrs Doogan will run the club. The cost of attending is 50p per day to buy in the food. Any shortfall will be covered by school funds. We will offer toast, cereal, pure juice cartons and fruit. It will promote healthy foods, and we won't be offering jam or chocolate spreads.

Breakfast Club runs 8.30am-9am daily.

Children coming into school on the bus will have plenty of time to attend the breakfast club and the club is open to **ALL** pupils. Children attending breakfast club can come into school from 8.30am. Only children going to breakfast club can come in early. Class teachers will

supervise in their classrooms as usual for 8.45am-9am daily. Breakfast club will run in the school hall.

Pilot

We hope these changes to our Extended Schools Programme will be beneficial to you all. This is a pilot year to see that the clubs on offer are viable. If the clubs are not well supported, they will not run again. Please do support all these activities. I know Thursday will not suit everyone, but it is the most suitable for staffing.
