#### Application and Decision Dates for admission to Junior Infants – 6<sup>th</sup> Class 2026/2027

**The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants – 6<sup>th</sup> Class**

1. The school will **commence** accepting applications for admission on Monday, 13th October 2025 at 8.30 a.m.

2. The school shall **cease** accepting applications for admission on Monday, 10th November 2025 at 2.15 p.m.

3. **Junior Infants only\***

The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

**Senior Infants – 6<sup>th</sup> Class**

The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025.

\* The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is between receipt of offer and Friday, 12th December 2025 @ 2.15 p.m.

**Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.**

**\*Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**
