Wraparound 2025 - 2026 Update

Wraparound booking/payment will be moving to ParentPay from Monday 15th September. This means that all payments will be made straight into the school system. If payment has not been made, your child will not have a space secured in Wraparound. You will be able to select days etc using this system just as you have with the old booking form system.
