Abusive or aggressive behaviour towards staff, whether in person, by telephone or via email, will not be tolerated.



What if I have a concern or worry? Who do I talk to?



If you have a concern you should make an appointment to speak with the class teacher first via the main office.

You will meet with the class teacher and depending on the concern, a referral to another staff member or team may be required.

If needed, another meeting will be scheduled for you to meet with suggested staff member or team e.g. SEN/CP/PP

If there are still unresolved concerns or worries then a meeting with the Vice-Principal/Principal will be arranged.
