HEALTH GUIDANCE

As mentioned in our school video message, this guidance relies heavily on families doing the right things to support each other.

Please note the following 3 Scenarios.

1. General Illness:

Please keep your child at home until day 2 of any illness and do a lateral flow test if you are unsure of the reason for this illness – before sending them back to school. (These tests can be ordered free of charge from NHS/PHA websites). If the lateral flow test is negative, the child should return to school. If it is positive, a PCR test should be booked immediately and the child should remain at home until the result is received.

2. COVID19 – Positive Case in Household

All members within the family/household should book/take a PCR test. Pupils should remain at home. After day 2, and the result being sent to the class teacher, we would appreciate that siblings/pupils remain home until the second test result is negative on Day 8. We will provide work activities to home.

Any family member who tests positive at any time should self-isolate for <u>10</u> days.

* Please inform school if a pupil tests positive at any time. We will connect with you for advice.

3. COVID19 – Positive Case in Child's Class

All of the pupils and staff must book and complete a PCR test.

Pupils can return after Day 2/when the negative result is sent to the class teacher via Seesaw. The child must also have no symptoms of COVID 19. All pupils and Staff have to retest via PCR on Day 8. A copy of this result should also be sent to the class teacher. If your child has no symptoms of COVID 19, they should return to school immediately.

An additional letter will be sent to you if there is a positive case in the class.

Key Points

- Please help us by doing the testing advised.
- Please ensure your device/Seesaw are working.
- Please get emergency childcare organised.
- Please order some Lateral Flow tests to have at home in case they are needed.
