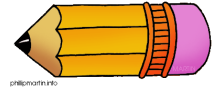
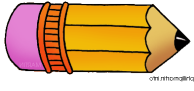

Classwork



In Primary Six our work is presented in topic form to tie all areas of learning together as much as possible.

This leaflet outlines what we will be covering in September / October in Numeracy and Literacy and through the theme of **You and Me**.

Please Note: - *Not all aspects of each subject are included in this document and all children work at different levels of ability.*

Numeracy

Number - place value up to 1 million; rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000; adding and subtracting using the formal written method as well as mental calculations; equivalent fractions and finding fractions of amounts.

Data Handling - reading and constructing tables and graphs (pictographs / tally charts)

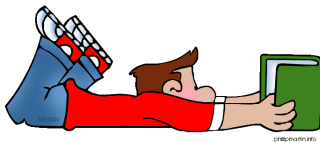
Shape & Space - plotting coordinates; identifying horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines; tessellating 2D shapes to make tiling patterns

Literacy

Sentence Work - Revising capital letters and full stops.

Grammar - Nouns, proper nouns, verbs, adjectives (past, present, future tense)

Spellings— We will be using our Prim Ed Spelling booklets. Each unit will last 2 weeks and activities will be completed in school and at home.



Children are expected to read each night for at least 10 minutes and to record this in their Reading Record. We encourage you to read with your child when possible.

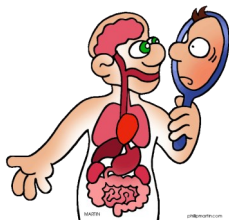
World Around Us

Rainforests - Location, different layers, plants, animals, weather, food, deforestation, conservation - all compared to our life, resources and experiences.



Viking Homelands - Where the Vikings came from, Sweden and N Ireland comparison, Viking towns and our town, Viking homes and our homes.

Human Body - Main organs of the body, circulatory System, pulse rate, healthy lifestyle, respiratory system, Digestive system, waste disposal system.



Personal Development and Mutual Understanding

PDMU this term, will involve the pupils looking at relationships within the class and amongst friends, the need for rules and boundaries, developing talking and listening skills and understanding the need for a healthy lifestyle.

Pupils will participate in discussions and have the opportunity to tell the class about their life / family outside of school through the use of a **Special Box** and during Circle Time.

Thinking Skills and Personal Capabilities

TSPC is a cross-curricular aspect of the primary curriculum. Through numeracy, literacy and other areas of the curriculum the pupils will become engaged in problem solving activities and discussions which will require them to take on different roles and develop confidence.
