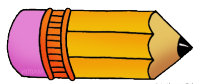

Numeracy

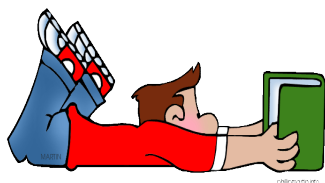
Number - Read and write numbers to 15.

Begin to add within 10.

Mental Maths- Count forwards and backwards to 15, number before and after to 15 and 1 more and less to 15



Measure- Days of the week and seasons.



Shape & Space -properties of 3-D.

Literacy

Children will have access to Home Reads and we encourage you to read with your child when possible.

Literacy

Reading— Try new words using first letter sounds, picture and context.

The difference between a line and a sentence.

Letter names a—h.

Identify beginning and end of sentences from capital letters and full stops.

Writing- Revising letter sounds and double sounds—ng, ai, ou, er, oo, ee, ch, th, sh.

Writing descriptions and instructions.

Talking and Listening- Listening to and following instructions.

Talking about our feelings and ourselves.

- Looking after my body.

- Looking at homes past and present.
