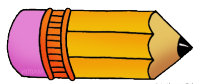

In Primary Two our work is presented in topic form to tie all areas of learning together as much as possible.

This leaflet outlines what we will be covering in November/ December in Numeracy and Literacy, through the theme of "Birthdays and Toys". This is to aid home learning.

Please Note: - *Not all aspects of each subject are included in this document and all children work at different levels of ability.*

Numeracy

Number - Read and write numbers to 20.

Add within 10, with cubes first then with number line.

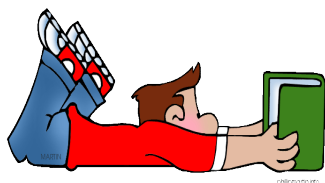
Subtract within 10.

Carry out simple shopping activities within 10p.

Mental Maths- Count forwards and backwards to 20. 1 and 2 more and less.

Measure- Order three objects according to their weight.

Shape & Space - 2D Shapes, circle, square, rectangle, triangle. Know directions left right, backwards and forwards.



Literacy

Children will have access to Home Reads and we encourage you to read with your child when possible.

Literacy

Reading— Try new words using first letter sounds, picture and context.

Identify speech marks and spoken words.

Identify beginning and end of sentences from capital letters and full stops.

Writing- Write familiar word families, cat, fat, rat. Begin to write high frequency words independently.

Use phonics to sound out and write stories.

Talking and Listening- Retell stories in correct order.

Listen to and follow everyday instructions.

Listen to and discuss stories.

World Around Us

- Effect of heat on food and ice
- Sort different types of toys, push, pull, battery.
- Know how different countries celebrate birthdays and Christmas.
- Match food items to the appropriate shop.

PDMU

- Recognise the similarities and differences of families and the wider community
- Understand that everyone is of equal worth and that it is acceptable to be different.



Thinking Skill and Personal Capabilities

TSPC is a cross-curricular aspect of the primary curriculum. Through numeracy, literacy and other areas of the curriculum the pupils will become engaged in problem solving activities and discussions which will require them to take on different roles and develop confidence.
