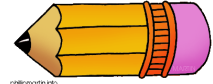
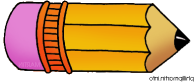


Shaping the future with learning,

In Primary Four our work is now presented in topic form to tie all areas of learning together as much as possible.

This leaflet outlines what we will be covering in March / April in Numeracy and Literacy and through the theme of **Space** so that home learning can be organised to support your child if you wish.

Please Note: - *Not all aspects of each subject are included in this document and all children work at different levels of ability.*

Numeracy

Number – Numbers to 1000, number lines and partitioning. HTU addition and subtraction. Adding and subtracting mentally. Investigating fractions, tenths and equivalent fractions. Multiplication using the partitioning, grid and expanded methods.

Time and Measure – Properties of shapes – horizontal, vertical, perpendicular and parallel lines. Litres and millilitres.



Literacy

Grammar and Punctuation — Revision of nouns, verbs and adjectives. Singular and plural words. Using connectives in a sentence. Writing in paragraphs.

Spellings — Continue with Prim-Ed Spelling Workbooks.

Writing — My Adventure in Space. Alien character study.

Shared Reading — Alphabetical order. Organisation and use of directories and dictionaries. Book covers, postcards and writing letters. Also continuing to extend comprehension skills.
