

# Kingsland N.S. - School Uniform Policy

The teachers and principal of Kingsland N.S. in conjunction with the Board of Management and parents have formulated this policy & it was updated on 24/3/25.

## Description of uniform;

- Navy blue trousers and navy sweater with crest with light blue shirt. (Navy tie is optional).
- Revised iron-on school crests will be available when current old crests run out of supply.
- Tracksuit, (Navy) No stripes/ logos/ No Hoodies or hoods with light blue polo shirt.
- No Football shirts.
- Girls may wear the above or navy skirts; pinafores and cardigans are also acceptable.
- Denim is not any part of the school uniform.
- The only jewellery permitted are watches, stud earrings and medical bracelets. Long earrings, necklaces & bracelets are not permitted.
- No make-up is to be worn by pupils.
- During warm weather, plain navy shorts may be worn that are not GAA shorts and of an appropriate length for school.
- 6<sup>th</sup> Class pupils may wear a ½ zip top by GRG with new school crest as school prefects. (2025-2026 school year)
- Jackets are not permitted to be worn in the classroom.
- No high heel shoes allowed.
- For Hygiene and Health & Safety, children with long hair are asked to tie it up & not have hair down loose.
- Parents will be contacted to collect children if uniforms get soiled during school.

## Note

Children are to wear the school uniform for the following.

- To school every day including P.E. days.
- School Photographs.
- Confirmation ceremonies.
- School events.
- Selected Church events.
