It is the Summer Solstice. Blessings of the long light to you!



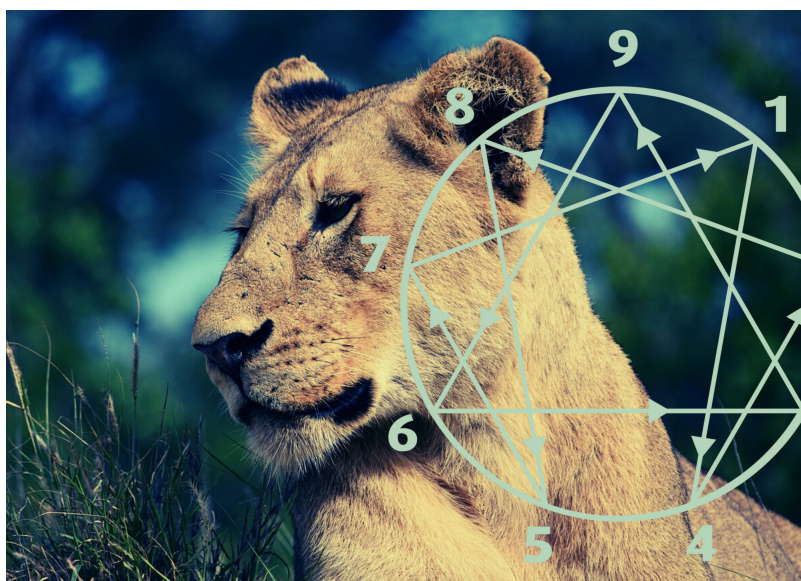

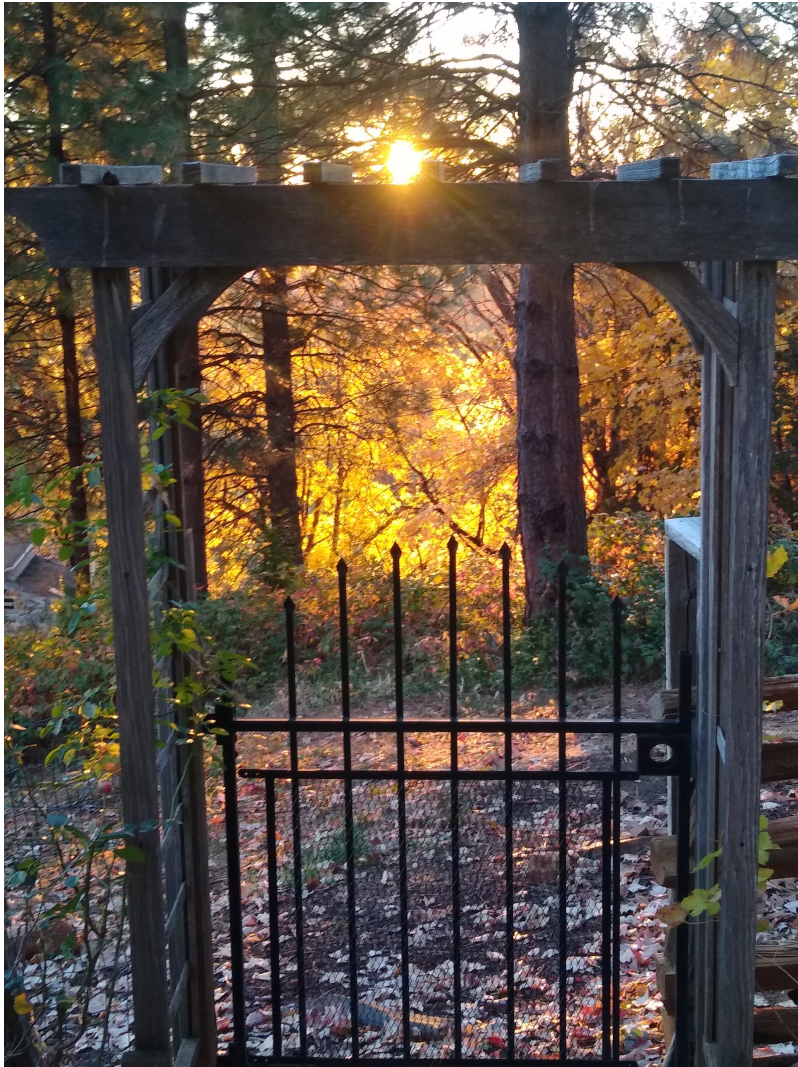
