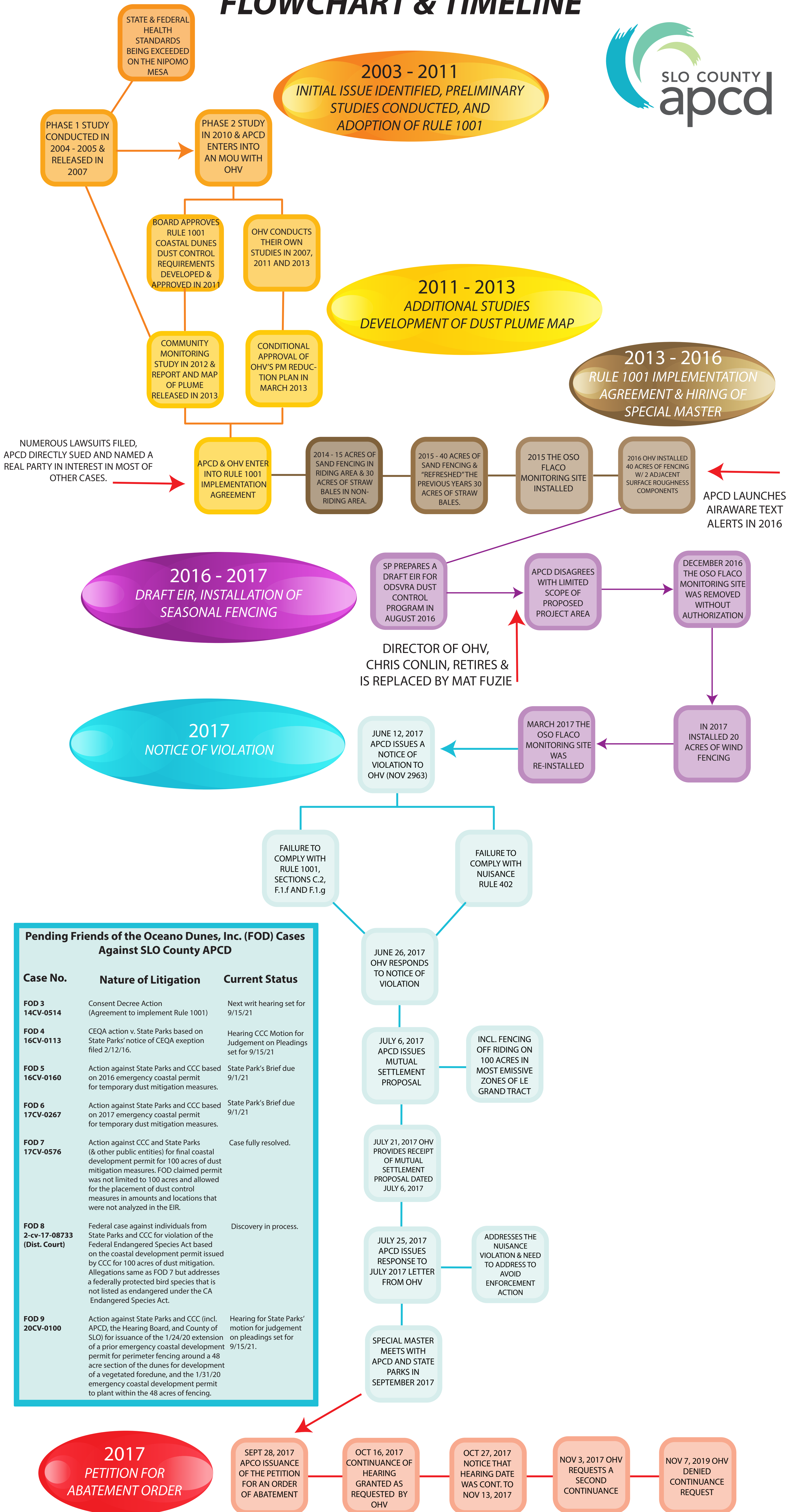


OCEANODUNES

FOD 4 16CV-0113	CEQA action v. State Parks based on State Parks' notice of CEQA exemption filed 2/12/16.	Hearing CCC Motion for Judgement on Pleadings set for 9/15/21
FOD 5 16CV-0160	Action against State Parks and CCC based on 2016 emergency coastal permit for temporary dust mitigation measures.	State Park's Brief due 9/1/21
FOD 6 17CV-0267	Action against State Parks and CCC based on 2017 emergency coastal permit for temporary dust mitigation measures.	State Park's Brief due 9/1/21
FOD 7 17CV-0576	Action against CCC and State Parks (& other public entities) for final coastal development permit for 100 acres of dust mitigation measures. FOD claimed permit was not limited to 100 acres and allowed for the placement of dust control measures in amounts and locations that were not analyzed in the EIR.	Case fully resolved.
FOD 8 2-cv-17-08733 (Dist. Court)	Federal case against individuals from State Parks and CCC for violation of the Federal Endangered Species Act based on the coastal development permit issued by CCC for 100 acres of dust mitigation. Allegations same as FOD 7 but addresses a federally protected bird species that is not listed as endangered under the CA Endangered Species Act.	Discovery in process.
FOD 9 20CV-0100	Action against State Parks and CCC (incl. APCD, the Hearing Board, and County of SLO) for issuance of the 1/24/20 extension of a prior emergency coastal development permit for perimeter fencing around a 48 acre section of the dunes for development of a vegetated foredune, and the 1/31/20 emergency coastal development permit to plant within the 48 acres of fencing.	Hearing for State Parks' motion for judgement on pleadings set for 9/15/21.

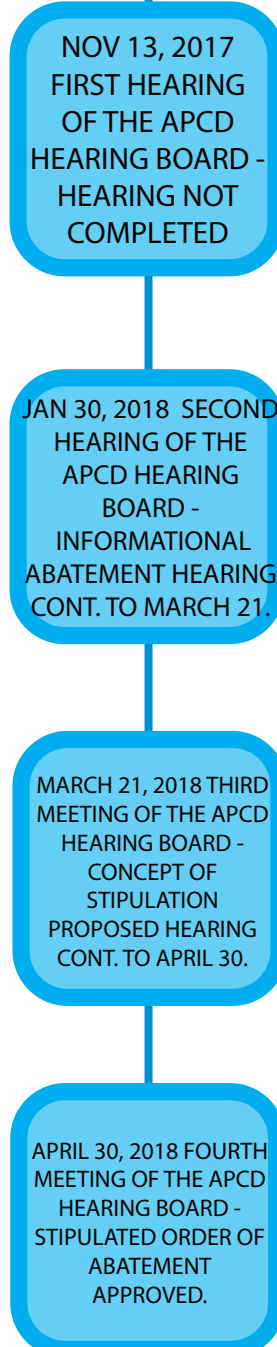

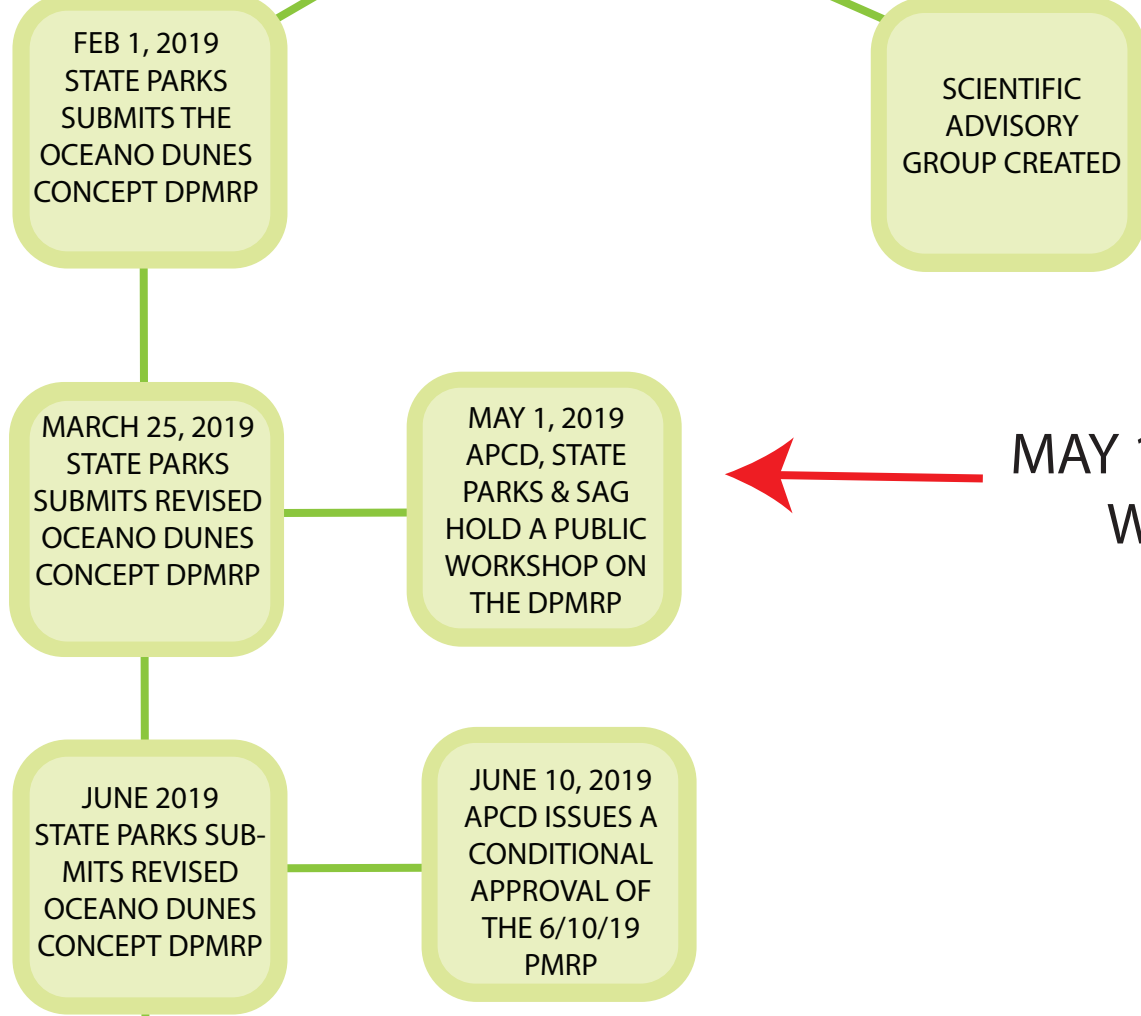

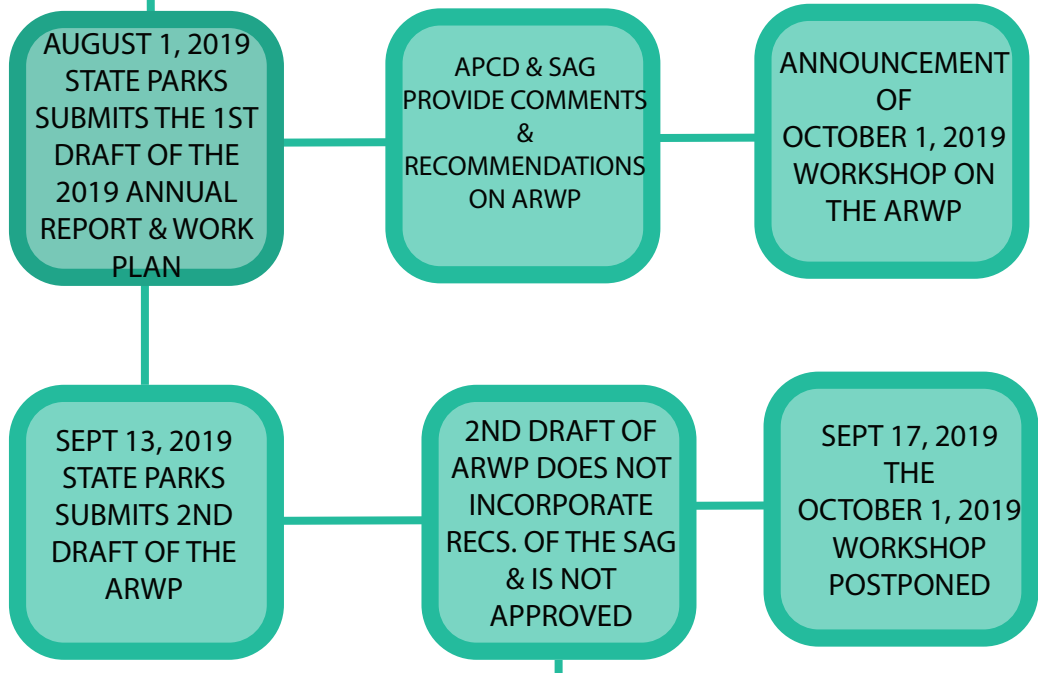
SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY GROUP CREATED

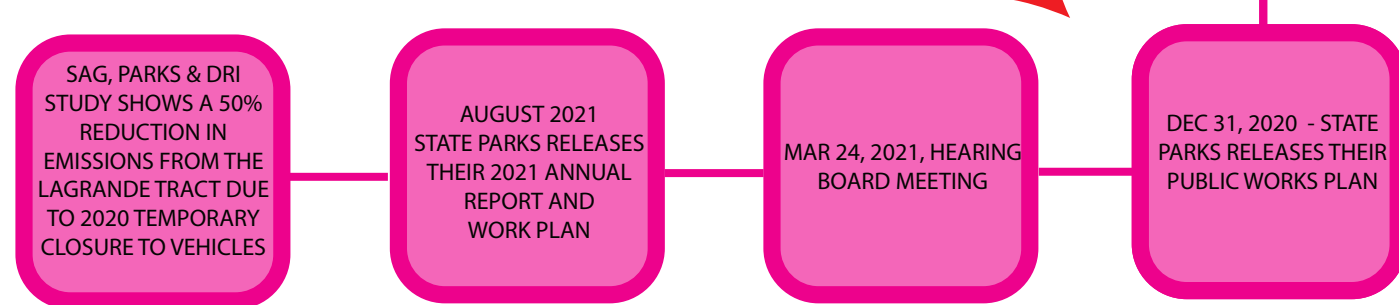
