SUBJECT: Conditional Approval of California Department of Parks and Recreation's 2024 Annual Report and Work Plan in Response to Stipulated Order of Abatement Number 17-01

Dear Sarah Miggins,

In accordance with Stipulated Order of Abatement Number 17-01 (SOA), a public workshop was held on October 15, 2024, to receive public comment on the provisionally approved 2024 Annual Report and Work Plan (ARWP) dated September 11, 2024. After considering public input, the District now grants final approval of the plan, subject to the following conditions:

1. If the Plover Enclosure area, in whole or in part, is reopened to public vehicular access, State Parks shall simultaneously implement District-approved dust controls sufficient to offset the resulting increase in emissions. If feasible, a final set of PI-SWERL measurements should be made in the area before it is reopened.
2. The emissions model shall be refined as proposed in the ARWP, including incorporating 2024 PI-SWERL measurements and expanding the modeling domain. These refinements shall be completed in time for updated modeling results to be included in the 2025 ARWP and for additional dust controls to be designed and installed by the expiration of the SOA if the refined modeling suggests that they are needed to comply with the SOA
