Best Practices Workshop

SAN LUIS OBISPO, Calif. –The Central Coast Clean Cities Coalition (C5) will host a Best Practices Workshop for Alternative Fuels on Thursday October 2nd from 3:00pm to 5:00pm in the San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District Auditorium - 3433 Roberto Court in San Luis Obispo.

This free workshop will provide guidance and recommendations on developing and deploying electric, natural gas and hydrogen infrastructure. Alternative fuel vehicles will be on display in the parking lot.

Experts from Southern California Gas Co. and Revolution CNG will give presentations on natural gas, UCSB's Alternative Fuel Coordinator will give presentation on hydrogen fueling infrastructure and C5's Coordinator will give an update on the status of electric vehicle charging in San Luis Obispo County.

C5 is part of the large effort to diversify the use of transportation fuels, promote clean vehicle technologies and help keep our environment clean.
