**Join Us and Visit an Energizer Station in Your Community!**

**SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA**, – On Friday, May 16, as part of Rideshare’s ongoing Bike Month activities the San Luis Obispo (SLO) County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) is sponsoring Bike to Work Day in SLO County. Plan your Friday bicycle commute and visit one of the 14 Energizer Stations in your community!

What are Energizer Stations? They are unique neighborhood bicycle commuting hubs that are hosted by groups who want to help you get energized about bicycle commuting. For this inaugural event, Rideshare and the APCD are collaborating with local businesses, cities, chambers, schools and organizations who will host 12 morning Energizer Stations and 2 evening Energizer Stations throughout SLO County.
