Two points:

1. The ODSVRA particulate matter reduction measures implemented in prior years, plus those to be implemented this year *are insufficient* to achieve the overall SOA objectives within the remaining time. The Hearing Board is duty bound to direct APCD staff and State Parks to provide a road map of prospective measures that demonstrates the feasibility of achieving the SOA objectives by the end of 2023. **Anything short of ensuring State Parks clearly and actively demonstrates the SOA objectives will be met within the prescribed timeframe is tantamount to irresponsible oversight.**

2. The draft PWP that includes significant development on the current Phillips property is such that requires Jim Anderson to resign or be removed from the Hearing Board due to ***significant conflict of interest***. This is clearly a no brainer.
