California State Parks continues to delay and obscure mitigation efforts that have been mandated to improve the air quality at the Oceano Dunes OHV State Park. In the meantime, during all the delays, the residents and outdoor workers continue to suffer continuing health issues due to the particulate matter coming from Oceano Dunes.

The Hearing Board has real power to hold CA State Parks accountable to comply with the rules set forth previously — no more “temporary” designations but permanent solutions.
