NOTICE OF HEARING AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT HEARING BOARD

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA: – The San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) Hearing Board is providing notice to the public that it will conduct a public hearing on Monday, November 18, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. at the South County Regional Center located at 800 West Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, California 93420. The hearing will discuss a new petition related to the existing Stipulated Order of Abatement 17-01 issued to California Department of Parks and Recreation Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Division. That Order was issued in April of 2018 concerns Particulate Matter emissions from the Oceano Dunes State Vehicular Recreation Area (SVRA).

The Hearing Board will consider possible modifications of the existing Stipulated Order of Abatement 17-01 (April 2018) or the issuance of a new Order of Abatement to address violations of state and local air quality regulations and standards.

The hearing will provide an opportunity for the public to make general comments and on any item considered. Written public comments may be submitted in advance of the hearing to info@slocleanair.org.
