I worked at Lopez High School on the Mesa since 1999/2000 school year. I retired at the end of 2010.

After I retired, I was diagnosed with multiple auto-immune diseases. In the course of treating me, my pulmonologist found I have interstitial pneumonia which is a fibrotic condition triggered by many different things, including airborne toxins.

There was no medical reason discovered for UIP. My (local) pulmonologist thought teaching on the Mesa at Lopez High School was a likely cause/trigger.

Since the pandemic, I have been tracking air quality at Calendar Rd on my Purple Air. After the initial windy spring with no traffic on the dunes, the air quality has improved markedly.

Please don't allow traffic back on the beach.

I live on the east end of Grand Avenue by the freeway entrance/exit. The air quality around my house is affected by heavy traffic on Grand Ave, especially the lifted big-tire trucks normally heading to the beach and lately protesting down Grand Ave.
