LONG CANYON VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PRESCRIBED BURN

San Luis Obispo County - Tentatively, Monday, October 23, 2023, through Friday October 27, 2023, a broadcast burn of 356 acres will occur along Huasna Valley Rd/ Mary Hall Rd in the Community of Huasna, East of Arroyo Grande CA. In cooperation with the SLO County Fire Safe Council, SLO County APCD and local landowners, firefighters from CAL FIRE will burn vegetation to help reduce fuel loading and create a more fire resilient landscape. Burning is expected to begin at 9:45 a.m. and conclude by 6:00 p.m.

Prescribed burning is an important tool used to minimize fire hazards and the likelihood of uncontrolled future wildfires that would have the potential to induce significant air quality impacts on the local community.
