## Prescribed Burning at Montaña de Oro State Park

Los Osos, San Luis Obispo County

**What:** Burning of approximately 270 brush piles.

**When:** Tuesday, November 16th through Friday, December 3rd, 2021. Actual burn days will be determined by weather conditions and permit conditions. Ignitions may start as early as 7 A.M. with fire activity curtailed by approximately 5 P.M.

**Where:** In the Eucalyptus forest in the vicinity of Camp KEEP and along the west side of Pecho Valley Rd., approximately 0.6 miles in from the park entrance.

**Why:** In order to reduce fuel loads and fire hazards associated with high fuel density.
