Prescribed Burning at Montaña de Oro and Hearst San Simeon State Park San Luis Obispo County

What: Burning of piles, understory fuels, and duff accumulation.

When: Wednesday, June 1 through Thursday, June 15, 2022. Actual burn days and locations will be determined by weather conditions and permit conditions. Ignitions may start as early as 7 A.M. with fire activity curtailed by approximately 5 P.M. Glowing piles may be visible at night.

Where: Montaña de Oro State Park: in the eucalyptus forest along Pecho Valley Road near the park entrance and Camp KEEP. Hearst San Simeon State Park, in the Monterey pine forest near the northern intersection of Highway 1 and Moonstone Beach Drive.

Why: In order to reduce fuel loads and fire hazards associated with high fuel density and diseased trees.
