## Dear Sarah Miggins:

Thank you for submitting a revised Second Draft 2022 Annual Report and Work Plan (draft ARWP) on time on September 14, 2022, as required by Stipulated Order of Abatement Number 17-01 (SOA). The Scientific Advisory Group (SAG) submitted its review of this draft on September 27, 2022. We are provisionally approving this plan as it adequately addressed the comments from the SAG and the District.

We have scheduled the public workshop for the draft ARWP to occur during the APCD Hearing Board meeting October 14, 2022, as part of a hearing to consider an amendment to the SOA. The meeting will be held remotely using Zoom teleconference software. The format for the workshop portion of the meeting will include a presentation of the draft ARWP by State Parks, and presentation on the adequacy of the ARWP and effectiveness of the mitigation by the SAG and APCD.

At this meeting, the Hearing Board will consider the APCD's application to amend the SOA. This amendment would revise the emissions reduction target of the SOA to a level consistent with the pre-disturbance scenario identified by the SAG in their "Scientific Basis for Possible Revision of the Stipulated Order of Abatement," dated February 7, 2022. It would also extend the term of the SOA by two additional years, among other changes. If State Parks does not stipulate to the amendment, or if the Hearing Board declines to approve it, State Parks will be required to implement the Secondary Work Plan described in Section 3.2 of the draft ARWP.

After considering all public comment received at the workshop, the District will make a final decision on the draft ARWP. Approval would likely be conditional. Feel free to contact me with any questions.
