Dear Hearing Board Members,

As you watch the presentations during the March 24 Update there are at least four issues that are concerning.

- Timing Why is the 2020/ 2021 dust mitigation being installed so late when it was approved in November?
- 2. Location Why is 25% of this mitigation outside of the riding area?
- 3. Transparency -Why weren't the four options for mitigation presented to the APCO and the public in August 2020. I had to obtain them with a Public Records Act request, and then it took 2 months. See attached options.
- 4. Accuracy Are the acres of mitigation being accurately counted and <u>not</u> double-counted. For example, 40 acres is fenced one year, awaiting native plants to be planted at a later date. When that later planting occurs in another year, or maybe 2 years, (20 acres one year and 20 acres in another year), are they being counted again as mitigation once planted.

I hope that you can give direction to the parties involved to address these concerns, either on the 24<sup>th</sup> or at a later date.
