THOUSAND HILLS PRESCRIBED BURN

San Luis Obispo County - Tentatively, Monday, October 2, 2023, and Tuesday, October 3, 2023, burning of hazardous vegetation will occur along Thousand Hills Rd. East of Pismo Beach. In cooperation with the SLO County Fire Safe Council, SLO County APCD, the National Weather Service, and local landowners, firefighters from CAL FIRE will conduct a 100 acre burn as a phase of the Thousand Hills Vegetation Management Project. Burning is expected to begin at 9:45 a.m. and conclude by 6:00 p.m.

Prescribed burning is an important tool used to minimize fire hazards and the likelihood of uncontrolled future wildfires that would have the potential to induce significant air quality impacts on the local community. Should conditions not be suitable for good consumption and optimal smoke dispersal, the burn will be rescheduled.
