REVISED OCEANO DUNES DRAFT PARTICULATE MATTER REDUCTION PLAN & PUBLIC WORKSHOP

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA: – In response to the Stipulated Order of Abatement (SOA) #17-01 with the SLO County APCD, California Department of Parks and Recreation (State Parks) submitted the Revised Oceano Dunes SVRA Concept Draft Particulate Matter Reduction Plan (DPMRP) on March 28, 2019, which was updated based on comments from SLO County APCD and the Scientific Advisory Group's (SAG) preliminary review of the initial February draft plan.

Today marks the beginning of a 30-day public review period for the DPMRP which can be found on the SLO County APCD website, SLOCleanAir.org.

We invite the public to participate in the upcoming May 1st workshop, which will provide an opportunity to review the DPMRP, solicit public feedback and discuss next steps. There will be presentations by APCD and State Parks, a question and answer panel with the SAG and breakout stations. The public may submit comments regarding the DPMRP in advance of the workshop, to info@slocleanair.org. All comments will be posted to the SLOCleanAir.org website following the workshop.
