Pile Burning

San Luis Obispo County - Tentatively, Monday, December 4, 2023, through Friday, December 8, 2023, pile burning of cut vegetation will occur near Obispo Ave/Richard Ave, above the Cayucos Cemetery in Cayucos CA. In cooperation with SLO County APCD and local landowners, firefighters from CAL FIRE will conduct burning of 200 piles. It is expected to begin at 9:45 a.m. and conclude by 6:00 p.m. Smoke may be visible in Cayucos.

Prescribed burning is an important tool used to minimize fire hazards and the likelihood of uncontrolled future wildfires that would have the potential to induce significant air quality impacts on the local community. Should conditions not be suitable for good consumption and optimal smoke dispersal, the burn will be rescheduled.
