### **GRANT FUNDING AVAILABLE TO CLEAN UP WOOD BURNING DEVICES**

**SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA:** – Funding is now available countywide to replace your old wood burning stove or fireplace. Applicants must live within San Luis Obispo County to replace their old, non-EPA-certified wood stoves, fireplace inserts or open-hearth fireplaces (that are used as a primary source of heat) with new, cleaner burning devices, such as EPA-certified woodstoves/inserts or natural gas or propane heating devices.

We are accepting applications countywide NOW; however, we are giving preference to those households that qualify as low income until August 31, 2018.

Low income households may qualify for up to \$4,000 and standard incentives may qualify for up to \$2,000!

This project is supported by the California Climate Investments (CCI) program, a statewide initiative that puts Cap-and-Trade dollars to work.

Grant funds for projects will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to qualifying projects based on the dates when APCD deems the submitted applications to be complete.
